
CLAREMONT SATELLITE CENTER

Hosting of one of four food pantries, the Claremont Satellite Center is located at 660 N. Mountain Avenue, Claremont, in the Joslyn Center Annex. This is a collaborative program between Inland Valley Hope Partners, Catholic Charities, Los Angeles, and the City of Claremont. Services offered to no, very low and low income families and individuals at the Claremont Satellite Center include:

- Emergency Food – 5 days of basic staple food for each member of your family.
- Rental and Move-in Assistance for Claremont residents, as well as others who have children in the Claremont School District
- Information and referral to other social service agencies.
- The Claremont Satellite Center serves an average of 160 individuals a month.

The services at the Claremont Satellite Center are provided by a dedicated group of volunteers.

Service hours are Tuesday and Thursday, 2:00 pm-5:00 pm, and Saturday, 9:00 am to 11:00 am.
