Who We Are ...

Celebrating over 50 years of commitment, Inland Valley Hope Partners serves over 75,000 men, women and children each year through "Our House" family residential shelter; and Rapid Re-Housing; SOVA, Claremont and San Dimas food pantries; and the Pomona Farmers' Market throughout 13 communities including Chino, Chino Hills, Claremont, Diamond Bar, La Verne, Montclair, Mt. Baldy, Ontario, Pomona, Rancho Cucamonga, San Dimas, Upland, and Walnut. The shelter houses five families for up to 90 days. The food pantries distribute five days worth of food per person to no and low income families. Clients may come once every 30 days. The Farmers Market operates every Saturday morning and accepts WIC and EBT cards. Begun in 1968 as the Pomona Council of Churches, today the non-profit is a collaboration of faith communities, businesses, community groups, and individuals who care about their neighbors.

The Beta Center Officially Re-Opens!



After months of waiting and preparation, we are thrilled to share that the Beta Food Security Center will be open by the time you receive this newsletter! We are overjoyed to once again welcome our Pomona neighbors and surrounding communities to this vital resource.



The new Beta Center is located at First Christian Church of Pomona (1753 N. Park Ave. at the corners of Garey and Pearl Aves.) and will serve individuals and families Monday through Thursday, from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. This centrally

located campus—also home to our administrative offices—allows us to better serve the community with food, resources, and encouragement all in one place.

What was once a dusty storage space has been transformed into a bright, welcoming food pantry designed with our clients' needs at the forefront. The space has undergone significant renovations, including the installation of a new exterior door for safe and convenient access, removal of interior walls to create an open and efficient layout, fresh paint, new shelving, and updated flooring.

We are deeply grateful to the donors who helped make this transformation possible, as well as our friends at Claremont Rotary and Interact Clubs, who generously volunteered their time to organize the space and stock the shelves so we could be ready to serve our neighbors from day one.



New users will need to create an account which requires some basic information, a valid email address, and a rewards card.

Matching gifts is a form of corporate philanthropy which allows companies to match their employees' donations to nonprofits. Companies will match their employees' donations at a 1:1, 2:1, or even 3:1 ratio, effectively maximizing the impact of a single eligible donation. 
