WAIVER

By signing below, I hereby acknowledge that I voluntarily desire to participate in the Inland Valley Hope Partners' Walk for the Hungry and Homeless at the Claremont Colleges Services (CCS) and associated locations. I hereby knowingly, freely and voluntarily agree to waive, release and discharge any and all claims against Inland Valley Hope Partners (IVHP), CCS, their authorized representatives or assigns for damages for death, personal injury or property damage to myself or to others that may arise, or that may subsequently accrue, as a result of my participation in the event. In consideration for being permitted to participate in the event, I hereby agree, for myself, my heirs, administrators, executors, and assigns, that I shall indemnify and hold harmless IVHP and CCS from any and all claims, demands, actions, or suits arising out of or in connection with my participation in the event. I also agree and acknowledge that myself and other booth participants may be photographed while participating, and release use of the photographs for reproduction in Hope Partners sponsored publications.

POLICIES AND REGULATIONS

- Registrations must be received no later than Tuesday, September 8, 2026. Registrations are processed on a first come, first served basis. Hope Partners reserves the right to refuse booth space to any individual, group, or organization that does not comply with the stated rules and regulations.
- **Booth participants are responsible for their own supplies including tables, chairs, and canopies.** No electricity is provided or will be available. Booths are encouraged to be festive, but all items must be within the 10x10 area of the booth. Any equipment that causes excessive noise is not permitted.
- In exchange for a free booth space at the Walk for the Hungry and Homeless event, **booth participants are required to provide a kid-friendly craft or activity.** Treats are also allowed. Based on previous year's attendance, we anticipate anywhere from 100 – 200 kids.
- **Booth set-up is from 7:00 a.m. to 7:45 a.m.** on the day of the walk and booths must be ready by 8:00 a.m. Booths must remain open until 11:00 a.m. unless otherwise instructed by a staff member or designee of Inland Valley Hope Partners. For the safety of everyone involved in the Walk, there will be no driving in the event area following or preceding the designated set-up and tear-down times.
- If a booth participant fails to abide by these policies and regulations, they may be asked to close their booth immediately.
